REGULATIONS PART 6 - THE REGISTER & REGISTRATION : CORRECTION

Please note we have been made aware of the following corrections and typographical errors and have arranged for Regulations Part 6 to be rectified.

Deletion of Clause 3.9 (c) in accordance with Item 7.5.7 of the October 2016 Board minutes. Copy of dot point (c) which has been deleted is noted below for information:

c. This part not applying in any case where the exhibit is registered with the recognised overseas canine controlling body as being owned or part-owned by a Member of an ANKC affiliated Member Body. (Amended 10/15, 6.1)

Correction of typographical error in Clause 10.1.1 (d). Copy of dot point (d) is noted below highlighting the correction:

a. The importer is to provide additional breed information, such as additional text expanding on the breed standard, photographs and diagrams to allow ANKC Ltd to prepare an appropriate Breed Standard Extension. The importer shall also provide written approval for the use of this material. (10/06 - 6.1.2, Amended 10/13 – 5.6.4)

Our website has been updated accordingly.

OBEDIENCE INTERPRETATION

Reference is made to the Group Exercises rule in the current ANKC Ltd Rules for the Conduct of Obedience Trials and in particular to clarification of the highlighted section noted below:

“Group Exercises:

*Group Exercises must consist of a minimum of three (3) dogs and a maximum of ten (10) dogs and must be judged by the same person who officiated in the individual exercises segment of the Trial. Each dog must have a separate Handler for the Group Exercises. **If there are insufficient entrants the Judge will ask the Steward to furnish stand-in dogs to make up a Group.** These dogs must be left on lead and the Handler must stay next to the dog in the heel position. Unless an exhibitor has multiple entries an exhibit must be handled by the one competitor for all exercises. In extreme weather conditions the Judge shall consider using areas of shade where practical to conduct the group stay exercises.*

The distance between dogs for all group exercises must be approximately two and a half (2.5) metres.”

The National Obedience & Tracking Committee has confirmed the following interpretation which shall be binding in accordance with the rules:

Once a dog has been withdrawn from the ring it is no longer being judged, no points awarded.

This being the case, it may cause insufficient dogs to be eligible for the stay exercises and the steward may ask for any dog to be a stand in for the stay exercises, even one which may have previously been entered and competed in the class in question, because once withdrawn is no longer part of that class.

Any dog that is being used as a stand in dog for the stay exercises must remain on lead, as per the rule book, regardless of what level the dog competes at.

PRESS RELEASE - FRENCH BULLDOGS

The huge increase in the popularity of the French Bulldog has created opportunities for unethical breeders to exploit the breed, the blatant disregard for the breed standard, and falsifying of colour, via pattern, enabling breeders to charge from \$10,000 upwards for puppies, based on the premise of Exotic and Rare Colours, has prompted the Board of Directors of the Australian National Kennel Council Ltd to establish a "Task Force" to investigate the corrupt practices affecting the breed and to make recommendations to strengthen the Regulations to protect the integrity of the registration process.

ALLOWABLE COLOURS

The ANKC Ltd Board resolved at the October 2016 Board meeting that the implementation date of 1 January 2017 for the following motion passed at the May 2016 Board meeting be deferred until 1 July 2017 pending receipt of submissions from National Breed Councils and Breed Clubs and further consideration by the ANKC Ltd Board:

“It was unanimously RESOLVED on the motion of P Frost/E Gunter that the Board endorses the National Breed Standards Coordination Group’s recommendation subject to the following highlighted changes:

“Effective from 1 January 2017 except in the case where National Breed Councils or Breed Clubs have nominated certain Colours not to be placed on the Main register as per regulations Part 6, 6.2.4 Special Conditions for Registration of Certain Breeds (Amended 04/15 EAP)”

Prior to 1 July 2017 only acceptable colours noted in the breed standards will be eligible for registration on the Main Register.

All Breed Clubs that have breeds which do not have a National Breed Council as well as Individual Members who have breeds which do not have a National Breed Council or Breed Club are requested to forward to their Member Body office a listing of what colours for their specific breed are not to be placed on the Main Register and to provide evidence for this request by no later than **COB 31 March 2017**. [Note: The evidence provided can be on the grounds other than health reasons.]

What will be the most popular dog breeds in Australia in 2017?

In an estimated canine population of 4.8 million nationally and 52% of all owned dogs being pure bred*, there's one breed Australians are still barking mad for – the loveable, family-friendly Labrador Retriever! But these large dogs may not be 'top dog' for long, as smaller canines are increasing in popularity.

According to registration figures of Dogs NSW, the controlling body of pure bred dog breeding and exhibiting in NSW, and Australian National Kennel Council (ANKC), Labradors have been the most popular breed for many years, but smaller canines such as the French Bulldog and Miniature Schnauzer are slowly wagging their tails to the top.

"It's no surprise the Labrador Retriever is still the most popular breed in NSW and across the country," said Lyn Brown, President of Dogs NSW. "Labs are friendly, energetic and fun-loving breeds with a good temperament, as well as very useful working dogs from search and rescue to assisting people with disabilities.

"But we are now seeing an increase in popularity of smaller breeds, such as French Bulldogs, Cavalier King Charles Spaniels and Miniature Schnauzers, because they are charming and more suitable for apartment style living."

In NSW, the French Bulldog, German Shepherd, Golden Retriever and Cocker Spaniel have all jumped up a spot, bumping off the gregarious British Bulldog and welcoming the lively and affectionate Miniature Schnauzer into the Top 10 most popular breeds.

Nationally, the French Bulldog and Miniature Schnauzer have climbed a step, leaving the playful Staffordshire Bull Terrier at No 2. – a position this adored breed has held for several years.

Be aware - dog fads attract 'breeders'

Mrs Brown said ANKC breeders are concerned that fashion, celebrity and social media-fueled pet breed fads are attracting the "breeders" who breed for profit, ending up with dogs with health problems or behavioural issues. Dogs NSW has recently launched a public and breeder education movement, 'Love is blind, but it doesn't have to be', to end irresponsible breeding, encourage responsible dog purchase and ownership, and work more closely with the veterinary community.

"ANKC-registered breeders who abide by the Council's breeding codes and guidelines carefully consider health issues, temperament and genetic screening, as well as individual care and placement of puppies in proper homes," said Mrs Brown.

Prospective owners also need to educate themselves about the breed, any inherited diseases and recommended health testing for that breed, she said.

“It is also the owners’ responsibility to find and work with a responsible breeder to ensure they are getting the healthiest and most suitable dog for their lifestyle,” said Mrs Brown.

“Our pets are not the latest fad – they are a long-term commitment. We encourage the pet industry and prospective dog owners to join the movement to keep healthy puppies in homes, where they belong.”

PIAA boarding kennels and catteries forum calls for change

The Pet Industry Association of Australia (PIAA) recently held an industry forum for the boarding kennel and cattery sector.

The forum came about due to a number of deaths in kennels over the Christmas and New Year period. After numerous talks, it was clear that there was a need for the sector to come together to discuss problems at hand and seek a way forward that ensures all kennels and catteries are transparent, accountable and complying with relevant codes of practice.

The PIAA forum on February 2 saw nearly 50 in attendance on the day. Invited guests included RSPCA NSW, TAFE, AVA NSW and various owners who had recently lost pets in facilities.

At present, all PIAA kennel members have to submit an annual PIAA vet audit and are also open to random inspections by PIAA. This is our benchmark for quality and sets PIAA members apart from non-member kennels. Unfortunately, PIAA membership is voluntary, so non-member kennels do not have to comply with PIAA Standards & Guidelines.

There are many kennels in the industry that do not comply with any standards or guidelines. PIAA wants to ensure that this does not continue. Many councils do not require kennels to be registered. We would like to see that change. Many councils do not enforce their codes of practice. We would like to also see that change. In NSW the Code of Practice is twenty-one years old and is well overdue for an update.

Many PIAA members, along with non PIAA kennel operators were also involved on the day. The member for Port Stephens Kate Washington spoke and pledged her support, as did RSPCA NSW and AVA NSW.

RSPCA NSW praised PIAA and said they had never seen or been invited to such a forum in 25 years.

They announced that they would partner with PIAA on this issue and meet with the Minister to see the 21-year-old codes updated. AVA NSW has also pledged to join forces to move for change.

The next step is to get councils on board as the regulators and ensure that the codes are updated, utilised, available and in the public eye. It won't be an overnight fix, but we have taken the lead on this and it is a great starting point.

PIAA would like to thank Hunter Pet Motel for hosting our forum and running a tour of their facility at the end of the meeting. We would also like to thank those members who attended from interstate.

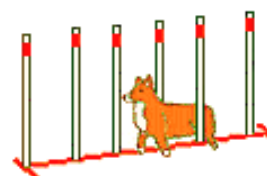

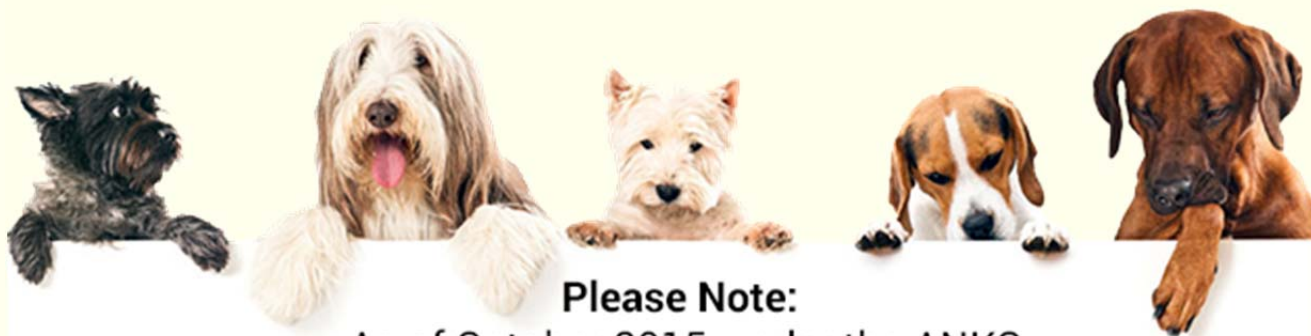
